Owner's Responsibility: Please verify with the entry clerk that your entries were received.

Payment Info: Please make checks payable to Great Lakes Region. Post-dated checks will not be accepted. Full payment must accompany all mailed entries. Per Show Rules 6.21 and 6.20, all online entries must be paid in full within ten (10) days of receipt or prior to the start of the show, whichever is first (cash, check or money orders accepted only). The use of the online entry form is interpreted as an official entry in this CFA show, and your email address on the form is considered to be your signature. No withdrawing entries once they're entered. There is a \$60 fee for any returned checks. **Payments not received within two weeks after the show date, will incur an additional \$50 late fee.**

Show Hours: Check-in is from 7:30 to 8:30 a.m. on Saturday, with judging beginning at 9 a.m. both days. The advertised show hours are: 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. both days.

Benching Requests: Every effort will be made to honor your benching requests to the best of our talents; but at least one request per exhibitor is guaranteed. A clerk near their ring is **not** counted as a request. Space provided, handicap requests will be benched at no charge to the exhibitor.

Hotel Information: Directions to the show hall and hotel listings will be sent with confirmation.

Transportation: Exhibitors are responsible for their own.

Food: Concession will be available for food and beverages. No outside food permitted, including grand cakes.

Miscellaneous: Show management will take reasonable care of cats and carriers, but will not be responsible for damage or loss. This is a NON-SMOKING facility with heating and air conditioning. Benching cage size is 22x22x22. Litter will be provided, bring your own pans.

Vetting: It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered, or present in the show hall, be inoculated by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (aka feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. Entries must have all claws clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not eligible for competition.

Scoring: Entries in Championship and Premiership (except Novice), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with a Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Owners of novices can contact the entry clerk for a temporary registration number (TRN). Kittens may be entered without registration numbers, but will not be scored for CFA awards unless a number is provided before the start of the show. Kittens without a registration number or a TRN will not be included in the count.
