Entry Fees:

\$55.00 - 1st entry (includes catalog)

\$45.00 – 2nd entry (same owner) **\$40.00** – 3rd entry (same owner)

\$160.00 – 4 pack special (same owner) \$30.00 – 5th etc. (same owner)

Free ½ cage with 3, 5 or 7 entries

 $$20.00 - \frac{1}{2}$ or sales cage$

\$40.00 - Grooming space

\$15.00 - End of Row (single entry must purchase an extra ½ cage)

\$10.00 - Saturday only - Special Evaluation Class for Egyptian Mau class only - must enter shows separately

Use of security cage with a single entry will require the purchase of an extra 1/2 cage

Show Hall: Jeffersonville Crossing 1148 McArthur Rd. Jeffersonville, OH. Phone: 740-426-6691. The show hall is a NON-SMOKING facility with heating and air conditioning. FOOD: Details being worked out and will be included with confirmation. All free parking for everyone.

Hours for Both shows: Check-In 7:00 AM - 8:00 AM. Judging hours are 8:30 AM-5 PM. Doors open to the public 9 AM-5 PM.

Entries: Entries must be typed or printed legibly, signed and submitted on an official CFA entry form or acceptable copy. Email entries must include all information normally on the Official entry form. Entries from the online entry form are equivalent to Official entry forms. Make checks to Sternwheel Cat Fanciers for both shows. Postdated checks will not be accepted. Full payment must accompany all mailed entries. All online entries must be paid in full within ten (10) days of receipt or prior to the start of the show, whichever is first (cash, check or money orders accepted only). There is a \$50 fee for any returned checks. Payments not received within two weeks after the show date, will incur an additional \$50 late fee. No substitutions will be accepted after the closing date. No refunds made once your entry is received or for failure to bench.

Show Hotel: There is no official show hotel, however a list of local accommodations will be sent along with confirmation.

Supplies: Clay litter will be provided. Please bring your own litter pans, cat food, and water/food dishes.

Health: This is a non-vetted show. It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, calici viruses and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. All cats must be free of mites, fleas, fungus and any contagious illnesses. Exhibitors in violation will be told to leave the show hall.

General: CFA Show rules will be strictly enforced and may be found at www.cfa.org/Publications/CFAManuals.aspx. Every entry must have all claws clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not eligible for competition. All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), Agility (if offered), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with an Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Owners of novices can contact the entry clerk for a temporary registration number. Kittens may be entered without registration numbers, but will not be scored for CFA awards if a number is not provided at show time. Kittens without a registration number or TRN will not be included in the count. It is the Exhibitors responsibility to check entry confirmation and notify entry clerk of any errors.

Benching: All Egyptian Maus will be benched together. Benching for all others will be by exhibitor and no changes in assignment will be allowed without permission of the Show Managers. At least one request per exhibitor is guaranteed, but efforts will be made to honor other requests to the best of our ability. Whenever possible, handicap requests will be benched with no extra charge. Cages are 22"W X 22"H X 22"D.

Egyptian Mau Breed Summit

The CFA Board of Directors has granted permission for a Breed Summit at the 2017 GEMS and Sternwheel Cat Fanciers shows



Special Evaluation class – Egyptian Maus only (10 cat limit) – Judge Melanie Morgan. Must enter separately and cat must be entered in regular show. Exhibitors may enter as many Egyptian Maus as they would like up to the class limit. Class will be at end of regular judging in Specialty ring. All cats will receive a written evaluation but will not be ranked or scored.

Best of the Best:

The following special breed awards have been approved:

In the 8 AllBreed rings, all Egyptian Mau classes (Kittens, Championship and Premiership) will be judged together. Judges will hang each class as usual and award top three in each category.

They will then award their "Best of the Best" regardless of class as follows:

0-15 Egyptian Mau entries: Top three Best of the Best

16-24 Egyptian Mau entries: Top four Best of the Best

25 Egyptian Mau entries or more: Top five Best of the Best

At the end of the Sunday show, top three in each category will be awarded based on class judging (ties broken by finals).

And, over all BEST Egyptian Mau will be awarded based on the Best of the Best scoring (ties broken by finals).

All Egyptian Maus will be benched by breed. Saturday after the show there will be a dinner with breed seminar. All Egyptian Mau breeders/exhibitors welcome – reservations required. Cost \$15.00. To make reservations email Caroline at Maudotz@aol.com.
