ROSETTES AND RIBBONS will be awarded in accordance with CFA show rules, which will govern the show. A copy of the rules and show standards is available for a nominal fee from CFA 260 E. Main St. Alliance, OH 44601 All rings will use permanent ring designations. All championship, premiership, kitten and HHP entries with registration numbers or recorded numbers will be scored for CFA National and Regional points. Owners of Novices should contact the entry clerk for current entry procedures.

SHOW MANAGEMENT will take reasonable care of cats and carriers, but neither Anthony Wayne Cat Fanciers nor the University of Michigan will be held liable for any loss or damages. It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhino tracheitis, Calicivirus and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. All cats/kittens must have all claws clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not eligible for competition.
