People food will not be available at the show. You are welcome to bring your own food. Lists of local places nearby for take out and delivery will be provided.

Checks payable to: MONROE SHORTHAIR (US FUNDS ONLY). Per Show Rule 6.21, all entries must be paid in full within 10 days of receipt or prior to the start of the show, whichever is first.

Entries submitted in the final 10 days before the show must pay at the check-in and must pay in cash. Absentee entries not paid prior to the start of the show must be paid within TWO weeks of the show or an additional \$25.00 late fee will be added. Faxed entries are not accepted.

NO REFUNDS/CANCELLATIONS after confirmation has been issued. Collect calls will be made in the event of entry errors or omissions. Exhibitors with security cages must purchase double cage spaces. NO CAGES ON MARKED GROOMING SPACES! All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with a Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Owners of cat/kittens without registration numbers can contact the entry clerk for a Temporary Registration Number. Kittens may be entered without registration numbers but will not be scored for CFA awards if a number is not provided at show time. This is a CFA licensed show, all CFA show rules will be enforced. For a copy of the show rules, visit <https://cfa.org/cfa-manuals/>. The club reserves the right to add judges not named in the flyer. A single cage measures approximately 22"x22"x26" and is included with your entry fee. Litter will be available; bring your own litter pans, cat food, and dishes. It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (fka feline distemper feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, calici viruses and rabies. (NYS requires proof of rabies) It is further recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. All claws of all entries must be clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not permitted in the show hall. All entries must be free of fleas, fungus, and infectious diseases. No kittens under the age of 4 months will be permitted in the show hall. The show hall is heated and air conditioned. The club will not be responsible for lost or stolen articles. Many area hotels take pets, a list will be sent with confirmation.
