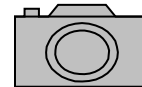

Owner's Responsibility: Please verify with the entry clerk that your entries were received. **ALL ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED THROUGH THE CFA WEBSITE. NO EMAIL OR PAPER ENTRIES CAN BE ACCEPTED PER SHOW RULES.**

Payment Info: Make checks out to Triple Crown Cat Fanciers. Per Show Rules 6.21 and 6.20, all online entries must be paid in full within ten (10) days of receipt or prior to the start of the show, whichever is first (cash, check or money orders accepted only), and the use of the online entry form is interpreted as an official entry in this CFA show, and your email address on the form is your signature. **No withdrawing entries once they are entered.** There is a \$50 fee for any returned checks.

Show Hours: Check-in is from 7:30 to 8:30 a.m. on Saturday with judging beginning at 9 a.m. and 8:30a.m. on Sunday. Advertised hours are Saturday: 9 a.m. – 5 p.m. and Sunday: 9 a.m. – 4 p.m.

Benching Requests: Every effort will be made to honor your benching requests to the best of our talents; but at least one request per exhibitor is guaranteed. A clerk near their rings is **not** counted as a request. If space provides, handicap requests will be benched at no charge to the exhibitor.

Hotel Information: Directions to the show hall and hotel listings will be sent with confirmation.

Transportation: Exhibitors responsible for own transportation.

Food: Concession stand will have food available. [The Swinery](#) will be serving Craft BBQ lunches. **No alcohol is allowed to be sold nor consumed per facility management.**

Miscellaneous: Show management will take reasonable care of cats and carriers but is not responsible for damage or loss. This a NON-SMOKING facility with heating and air conditioning. Benching cage size is 22x22x22. Litter provided, bring own pans.

Vetting: It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. All cats/kittens must have all claws clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not eligible for competition.

Scoring: All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with a Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Owners of novices can contact the entry clerk for a Temporary Registration Number.
